Boca Prep Toilet Training Policy

Toilet training is an important milestone for young children. We define successful independent toileting as having the ability to lower his/her underpants (as well as deal with other clothing), completing the act of urinating and/or defecating in the toilet, wiping themselves, flushing and re-dressing themselves.

All Boca Prep students must be toilet trained before entering school. This policy is in place for the health and safety of our students and because the classrooms are not equipped with a diaper changing table/station or diapering supplies. If a child has three or more accidents within a three week timeframe, a probationary warning will be issued. If another accident occurs during the probationary period, the child will be required to stay home until securely potty trained. The child's place will be held for the remainder of the month. Required potty training is standard practice among area schools.

If a child has two accidents in one day, the family will be notified to come and pick up the child for the remainder of that day. If the child continues to have frequent accidents on a daily basis, the school will temporarily un-enroll the child from school until complete toilet training is achieved. Written warning will be given to the parents before this action takes place.
