

## Lower School Dress Code

| CLOTHING                          | GIRLS   |
|-----------------------------------|---|
| <b>Shirts</b>                     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Boca Prep logo oxford cloth shirt (white Dress Uniform).</li> <li>• Boca Prep logo polo shirt (navy or white).</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Undershirts</b>                | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Short/long sleeve undershirts in a solid color with no visible logos (navy or white).</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Hooded Sweatshirts</b>         | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only approved Boca Prep hooded sweatshirt with logo may be worn to school.</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Skirts/Skort</b>               | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Boca Prep plaid or khaki skort.</li> <li>• Must be at least four fingers from the top of the knee in length, neatly hemmed, and may not be rolled at the waist. Parents are to check the length of the skirts/skort during the year as the child grows to ensure proper coverage and modesty.</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Shorts</b>                     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Khaki shorts must be at least four fingers from the top of the knee in length and neatly hemmed.<br/><i>May not be rolled at the waist.</i></li> </ul>   |
| <b>Pants</b>                      | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Khaki pants</li> <li>• Neatly hemmed<br/><i>Leggings and cargo pants are not permitted</i></li> </ul>  |
| <b>Socks/Knee Highs/Stockings</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Crew socks which have no logos and are clearly visible above the shoe line (navy only) White socks for PE days.</li> <li>• Knee highs must be solid in color with no patterns (navy only)</li> <li>• Stockings must be solid in color with no patterns (navy only)<br/><i>Nude stockings/knee highs are not permitted.</i></li> </ul>  |
| <b>Shoes</b>                      | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Traditional leather dress shoes in a solid color (dark brown, black, or navy).</li> <li>• Velcro sneakers for Pre-K (For all uniforms)<br/><i>No open-toe, light-up, sling-back, backless, sandal, clog, flip, stacked/elevated heel, athletic or boot type shoe is permissible (Uggs, Vans, Toms, slippers, Crocs, Converse).</i></li> </ul>  |
| <b>Hygiene</b>                    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hair should be cut in a traditional style (<i>rat tails and mohawks/fohawks are not permitted</i>), and maintained, so that it is neat and clean in appearance. Unkempt hair is unacceptable. Hair may not be dyed unusual or bizarre colors. Bizarre/unusual is any color other than natural hair colors (for example: blonde, brown, red and black).</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Make-up</b>                    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Girls are not permitted to wear excessive make-up.</li> <li>• Girls are not permitted to wear press-on nails.</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Jewelry</b>                    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Necklaces and bracelets may be worn if they are small in size (non-distracting) and do not exhibit any offensive symbols.</li> <li>• Earrings may be worn by girls only and must be no larger than 1” in diameter.</li> <li>• Wide gauge stretchers are not allowed.</li> <li>• Bandanas, scarves, and hats are not authorized.</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Tattoos/Piercings</b>          | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Visible tattoos and piercings are not permitted</li> <li>• Writing on hands, arms, and legs is not permitted.</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Other</b>                      | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students may not alter the bottoms or tops except to make them fit properly.</li> <li>• Religious exemptions to the Dress Code may apply.</li> <li>• While in Boca Prep uniform outside of school students must remember that they are representatives of the school and must behave appropriately.</li> <li>• Please refer to the Dress Code <b>before</b> purchasing any articles of clothing for school. Your ongoing support of the mandatory uniform is assumed by your membership of the school.</li> <li>• Boca Prep caps may be purchased and may only be worn outside.</li> <li>• Appropriate safety gear (shin guards, goalie gloves, etc.) required.</li> </ul> |

| <b>Shirts</b>             | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Boca Prep logo oxford cloth shirt (white Dress Uniform).</li> <li>• Boca Prep logo polo shirt (navy and white)</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Undershirts</b>        | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Short/long sleeve undershirts in a solid color with no logos (<del>black</del>, navy, or white).</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Hooded Sweatshirts</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only approved Boca Prep hooded sweatshirts with logo may be worn to school.</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Shorts</b>             | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Khaki cargo shorts</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Pants</b>              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Khaki pants</li> <li>• Must be neatly hemmed</li> <li>• <i>Skinny jeans and cargo pants are not permitted</i></li> </ul>  |
| <b>Socks</b>              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Crew socks which have no logos and are clearly visible above the shoe line (tan, navy, black, or white).</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Tie</b>                | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Boca Prep striped tie</li> <li>• <i>From Dennis <b>ONLY</b></i></li> </ul>  |
| <b>Belt</b>               | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plain leather uniform belts are to be worn with pants on dress days (dark brown, or black). Exempt: Pre-K and Kinder</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Shoes</b>              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Traditional leather dress shoe in a solid color with no logos or embellishments (dark brown, black, or navy).</li> <li>• Velcro sneakers for Pre-K (For all uniforms)</li> <li>• <i>Sandal, light-up, flip, athletic or boot type shoe is not permitted (Ex. Uggs, Vans, Toms, Slippers, Crocs, Converse)</i></li> </ul>  |
| <b>Hygiene</b>            | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hair should be cut in a traditional style (rat tails, mohawks/fohawks, ponytails or man-buns are not permitted), and maintained so that it is neat and clean in appearance. Unkempt hair is unacceptable. Hair may not be dyed unusual or bizarre colors. Bizarre/unusual is any color other than natural hair colors (for example: blonde, brown, red and black).</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Jewelry</b>            | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Necklaces and bracelets may be worn if they are small in size (non-distracting) and do not exhibit any offensive symbols.</li> <li>• No earrings</li> <li>• Wide gauge stretchers are not allowed.</li> <li>• Bandanas, scarves, and hats are not authorized.</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Tattoos/Piercings</b>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Visible tattoos and piercings are not permitted. Writing on hands, arms, and legs is not permitted.</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Other</b>              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students may not alter the bottoms or tops (of any school uniform) except to make them fit properly. (For example: you cannot cut slits at the bottom of pants or cut necks out of shirts)</li> <li>• Religious exemptions to the Dress Code may apply.</li> <li>• While in Boca Prep uniform outside of school students must remember that they are representatives of the school and must behave appropriately.</li> <li>• Boca Prep caps may be purchased and may only be worn outside.</li> <li>• Appropriate safety gear (shin guards, goalie gloves, etc.) required.</li> </ul> |
