Extra-Curricular Program Description

KISO Swim

Dive into our Monday Swim Academy, providing water safety skills, stroke technique & fitness development.

Cozy Slippers Book Club (PreK – K)

Join in the fun with thematic books, songs, rhymes, movement activities, crafts and storybooks online while building language and literacy skills. Children will be exposed to the wonder of the spoken word and the magic of books while wearing their favorite cozy slippers!

Reading Bug Club (PYP1 – PYP2)

Join Miss Chantal in reinforcing a lifelong love of learning by exploring the wonderful world of books! Children will discover age appropriate authors and illustrators, and become one themselves through literacy activities that will foster both reading and writing skills.

SSYRA (Sunshine State Young Readers' Award) Club (PYP3 – PYP5)

SSYRA is a statewide reading motivational program for students in grades 3 through 8, sponsored by the Florida Department of Education (DOE) and Florida Association for Media in Education (FAME). The purpose of the SSYRA Program is to encourage students to read independently for pleasure and to read books that are on, above, and below their reading level in order to improve their reading fluency. Together we will explore the books listed in this year's selection and participate in a statewide vote on our favorite titles in the Spring of 2017.

Gamers Unplugged

Board games that increase brain power! A fun way for kids to follow rules, focus, take turns, participate in a decision-making process, strategize, and think creatively.

Movie Club

Ready, set, action! The students will have an opportunity to watch different movies throughout the enrichment program. The students will reflect on their favorite parts, characters, and settings.

Green Club

The mission of the Green Club is to make a positive impact on our environment while having fun. Our goal is to educate, inform and inspire students to protect habitats, eco-systems, and animal life.

Mad Minute Math

Students will be working with 2-3 digit numbers, adding/subtracting problems, and word problems. Students will utilize timed worksheets and worksheets for reviews as well.

Beginner Band

Band enrichment is offered to students who play (or want to learn to play) a brass, woodwind, or keyboard percussion instrument. This class is best suited for students in 3rd, 4th, or 5th grade. To choose an instrument, please schedule a time with Mrs. Goodman to try out the one that would best fit your child. Students who attend regularly will have the opportunity to perform at concerts, solo and ensemble, and off-campus events.

Advanced Band

Advanced Band is open to students in the PYP3, PYP4, and PYP5 who have at least one year of band experience. Students may choose from the following instruments:

Flute – Oboe – Bassoon – Clarinet – Saxophone – Trumpet – Horn – Euphonium – Trombone – Tuba - Xylophone

Playground

Children participate in fun fitness and sports games from different countries. The activities reinforce the PYP curriculum while promoting healthy physical activity.

Research Hall

Research hall gives students an opportunity to finish homework in a quiet/supportive setting and allow for individual tutoring from the supervising teacher. Great study skills set the foundation for all classroom learning. Students in this class will develop their approaches to learning skills by developing practical and useful strategies and techniques for managing their studies.
