



Boca Prep Uniform Policy 2024-2025

Our school uniform teaches students to dress smartly, take pride in their appearance and their school. Parents are asked to help the school in carrying out the school's dress code standards by ensuring that their child is properly groomed and dressed in their uniform when they leave for school each morning.

Working together under the same set of standards contributes to a cohesive student body with strong camaraderie, integral to building a strong school spirit and sense of pride.

Wear the Polo shirt (navy and white) and Oxford shirt (white dress uniform) that may be purchased through our school uniform company.

1. Assembly uniform must be worn only during assembly days (ties and button-down shirts), no hoodies during the assembly.
2. Plain leather uniform belts are to be worn with shorts or pants (dark brown, or black)
3. Khaki pants (neatly hemmed)
4. Shoes must be solid black in color (including soles), no high-tops or embellishments
5. Crew socks must be at the ankle
6. Boys are not allowed to wear earrings
7. No visible tattoos
8. Boys' hair must be cut in a short traditional style
9. Girls' skirts must be at least four fingers from the top of the knee in length
10. Girls must wear shorts underneath skirts, unless wearing a 'skort'
11. Girls are not permitted to wear press-on nails or wear excessive makeup
12. Girls solid (black, navy, brown) color headbands may be worn
13. Students may not alter the school uniform in any way
14. Hair dye for any student is not permitted; students must have natural looking color hair.

Appropriate Uniform Guidelines:

- Polo shirt (navy and white)
- Khaki shorts/pants
- School hoodie
- No Hemmed skirts or skorts
- Boys must wear belts with all uniforms (black or dark brown)
- Dress uniform
 - Oxford shirt
 - Boys striped tie
- Shoes (black) solid in color
- Crew socks (tan, navy or black)
- Short traditional haircut for boys
- Hair dye is not permitted; natural color only
- No tattoos may be visible
- Male students are not permitted to wear earrings
- Female students can not have excessive ear piercings
- Seniors may wear college sweatshirts over their school uniform on Fridays only
- School-sponsored clubs/events attire may be worn on designated days

If there are any questions about the uniform guidelines, please contact your child's mentor. This should be done prior to purchasing clothing items or changing one's own personal appearance.

All parents must understand and agree that if their child does not come to school in the correct uniform, the school will contact parents to bring the appropriate uniform items or send the student back home until they are in proper uniform attire.
